

CONSTITUTION.

- I. Name: The society shall be called the "Crama Bharathi Education society".
- II. Location: The Headquarters of the society shall be in Krishnaraipet Town.
- III. Aims and Objects:
1. To create facilities for primary, Secondary and University Education.
 2. To run student's Home.
 3. To conduct Residential schools and Colleges.
 4. To conduct vocational Institutions.
 5. To run such other institutions as may be essential for the furtherance of the aims and objects of the society.
 6. To undertake such development concerns as can be more purposeful and make the purpose more effective and efficient by earning additional income.

IV. General Body: General Body consists of:-

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1. Ordinary members contributing Rs.50/- annually.
 2. Life members contributing Rs.250/-
 3. Donors contributing Rs.500/- or more.
 4. Patrons contributing Rs.1,000/- or more.
 5. Members of the staff of the various institutions run by the society, who have put in atleast three years of service as permanent staff shall be the ordinary members of the society and are not eligible to stand for election or to be nominated to the Governing council.

Founder Members:-

Sri.S.M.Lingappa, B.A.II.B., M.L.A., Krishnaraipet.

Explanation:-

1. The contributions promised by the ordinary members shall be payable within the expiry of the official year from the date of promise.
2. Persons who are ordinary members of the society continuously for five years or more shall be considered to be the life members of the society.
3. The contributions promised by Life Members, Donors and patrons shall ordinarily have to be paid within one year or within such period, as the Governing council prescribes from time to time.
4. Persons of either sex who have completed the age of majority and are not otherwise disqualified as shown by the bye-laws shall be eligible to become members.
5. Persons contributing less than Rs.50/- shall be called as sympathisers with no power of voting.

V. GOVERNING COUNCIL:-

1. The governing council shall consist of nine members.
2. The founder member shall be the permanent member of the Governing council.
3. There shall be 8 elected members by the general body and the remaining 2 to be elected by the governing council at its first meeting after the general body meeting.

4. The governing council shall be elected by the general body members once a year in their annual general body meeting.
5. The Head Masters, Deputy Superintendents and Principals of the sub-ordinate institutions shall be ex-Officio members of the Governing council without the power of voting.

OFFICE BEARERS:-

1. The governing council shall elect a president a Vice-President a Secretary and a Treasurer in its first meeting after the annual General Body Meeting.
2. The governing council shall have powers to appoint Head Masters, Deputy Superintendents and Principals for each of the institutions under its management.

VII. Powers and Management:-

1. The entire management of all the society and all the sub-ordinate institutions and the Trusteeship of the movable and immovable properties, permanent funds and also the income belonging to the Institutions shall vest in the governing council.
2. The governing council shall have powers to accept and collect gifts of either movable or immovable property on behalf of the society and allocate to the same and to make sales of immovable property under special circumstances, with the previous sanction of the general body.
3. The governing council shall have powers totake such undertakings as Cinema House, workshops, business houses etc., which can yield income for their development of its activities.
4. The governing council shall have powers to appoint as many sub-committees as it deems fit.
5. The governing council shall have powers to appoint teachers, who are duly qualified.
6. The governing council shall have powers to grant leave, to appoint substitutes and to accept resignations.
7. The governing council shall have powers to frame rules and bye-laws in consonance with the constitution.
8. The governing council shall have powers to raise loans from Banks, Societies or individuals by pledging if necessary any property of the "Grama Bharathi Education Society".

VIII. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE PRESIDENT:

1. The president shall be executive Head of the Governing council.
2. He shall preside over all the periodical meetings of the Governing council and the annual meeting of the General Body as well as the General Body meetings specially convened.
3. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall exercise all the powers and perform all the functions of the President.

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IX. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY.

1. He shall in addition to his functions as Secretary of the Governing council be the superintendent of all the institutions run by the society.
2. He shall be the custodian of all the records, furniture and the properties of the society.
3. He shall have powers to issue cheques and make payments or issue cheques for purposes approved by the Governing council.
4. He shall have powers to pass bills for payments.
5. He shall be the convenor of the meetings of the Governing council and the general body.



X. MEETINGS OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL:

1. The Governing council shall ordinary meet once in a month to check and to pass the accounts of the institutions and to consider the subjects brought up for discussions.
2. Five days notice of meeting with the agenda shall be given to all the members of the governing council by the Secretary.
3. Special meetings of the Governing council may be called for either by the Secretary or the president or on the written requisition of atleast five members of the Governing council.
4. One third of the members shall form the quorum.
5. No quorum is necessary for an adjourned meeting.

XII. GENERAL BODY MEETING:-

1. The annual meeting of the General Body shall be hold in the premises of the Headquarters of the Institution or at any place belonging to the society ordinarily in the month of July each year, when a detailed report of the Institution together with the statement of accounts for the previous year shall be placed before the general body.
2. The notice of the general body meeting with the Agenda shall be given to all the members one week in advance.
3. Thirty members shall form the quorum for the General Body meeting.
4. The President or in his absence the vice-President shall preside over the general body meeting. If both are absent, the members shall elect a chairman from among the members present to conduct the general body meeting. The provision applies to the Governing council meeting as well as extra ordinary general body meeting.
5. Special meetings of the general body shall be called for by the Secretary at the instance of the governing council or on the written requisition of at least 25 members.

XIII. FUNDS AND OTHER PROPERTIES:-

1. The Governing council shall deposit the funds of the Institution in the S.C.C. Bank, The Mysore Bank, The Vijaya Bank or any other recognized Bank.
2. Any person or persons that may be authorised or appointed by the general body at the annual meeting shall audit the accounts of the Institutions.

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
